2025 Scholarship Official Rules and Guidelines

Eligibility: Each contestant must be of Albanian decent and a senior enrolled as a student in an American public or private school or is in a home education program, and able to provide a transcript, letter of recommendation and a college acceptance letter. Each student may enter only one essay, written in English, no longer than 750 words. Plagiarized essays will be subject to disqualification.

Entry Dates: Entries can be mailed to AAEA PO Box 58 Yonkers, New York 10704 or submitted electronically at www.aaeany.@gmail.com. All entries must be received electronically no later than 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time on Friday May 2nd, 2025. Entries submitted electronically will receive an email confirmation. All mailed entries must be post marked by May 2nd, 2025. Contestants are responsible for all postage and shipping costs.

Entry Form: Student must provide all required information requested on the entry form and information must be legible. The student and parent/legal guardian are required to read and understand these rules in order to complete the entry form in its entirety. The entry form includes a release and certification that must be signed by the contestant.

Labeling Requirements: Essays must include student's name, home address, telephone number, school the student attends, grade level, title of the essay, and a word count. Essays must be no longer than 750 words in length, written in English, and should be typed.

Disclosure: AAEA, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to disqualify any person tampering with the entry process, the operation of the website or who is otherwise in violation of the Official Rules. Entrants agree AAEA has the sole right to decide all matters and disputes arising from this contest and that its decision is final and binding. AAEA reserves the right to publically share the Essay and the name of winners. Essays and applications become the property of AAEA once submitted.

Awards: Winners will receive a 1st Place \$1000 scholarship reward or the 2nd Place Alexander Thomas Delic \$500 award or **3rd Place \$250 and a Laptop Computer** in person by mail. Once the winners are announced, the decision is final. Winners will be announced by May 23rd, 2025
